IMMANUEL LUTHERAN CDC SUMMER PROGRAM

Grades 1-5

June 3 - August 16

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Planted under the SON

Children will learn about gardening by preparing the soil, planting seeds, watching the seeds germinate, watering and care as their produce grows. Jr. Master Gardeners from University of Idaho will be doing two sessions with the children on horticulture. Agriculture in the Magic Valley is very important. Children will enjoy a week "on the farm" when Farm Bureau brings in MAC (Moving Ag into the Classroom) Trailer to our facility.

Outdoor Safety (One day each for outdoor survival, Marine Safety, Electrical Safety and a Bike Rodeo)

Classes on outdoor survival and marine safety will be presented by the Twin Falls County Sheriff office. Children will learn safety tips if they are ever alone in the mountains or outdoors. In August, the county will bring the marine trailer to help children learn how to handle a water craft safely. A bike rodeo will be organized by the Twin Falls Police. Idaho Power will instruct the children on electrical and water safety.

When I grow up...

I want to be a ??? Throughout the summer will be having career days. Guests from different professions will visit and tell about their career. Children will have the opportunity to hear about becoming a doctor, veterinarian, teacher, minister, bee keeper, dentist, and many more.

Moving with the Beat

Children will have the opportunity to enjoy yoga, Zumba and aerobics. It will be fun moving to the beat and exploring different music styles.

So...You Think Can Sew! (All Day – one day only - July 16)

For the past summers this class has been a favorite of the children. Jean Kriwox will come and help the children learn valuable "tricks of the trade" in this sewing class.
