Planted under the SON

Children will learn all about gardening by preparing the soil, planting seeds, watching the seeds germinate, watering and care as their produce grows. Jr. Master Gardeners from University of Idaho will be doing two sessions with the children on horticulture. Agriculture in the Magic Valley is very important. Children will enjoy a week "on the farm" when Farm Bureau brings in MAC (Moving Ag into the Classroom) Trailer to our facility.

Outdoor Safety (One day each for outdoor survival, Marine Safety, Electrical Safety and a Bike Rodeo)

Classes on outdoor survival and marine safety will be presented by the Twin Falls County Sheriff office. Children will learn safety tips if they are ever alone in the mountains or outdoors. In August, the county will bring the marine trailer to help children learn how to handle a water craft safely. A bike rodeo will be organized by the Twin Falls Police. Idaho Power will instruct the children on electrical and water safety.
